The Ripple Effect

Meet 35-year-old Richard Ocen, a construction worker for H4H and member of Te-opok village. At just eight, he lost his father, an ordinary farmer, who was arrested and killed by LRA rebels. At 22, Richard married Nancy Apiyo and they began living in a grass-thatched hut. Termites, leaks, and thieves were constant worries, and they even endured their hut burning to the ground in a brushfire.



For the past three years, Richard has been responsible for digging all of the latrine pits that are provided with each home in Northern Uganda. This income stability allowed him to begin saving and pay the annual school fees for his 3 children. He's also been able to purchase goats, cows, and chickens.



In October, Homes For Homes began constructing homes in Te-opok, Richard's village. Thanks to your generosity, his family has a brick home! They live securely, free from leaks and roof repairs. He's proud to be a living testament to the positive impact Homes 4 Homes brings to Northern Uganda, and he's determined to keep working, saving, and thriving Your gifts have changed Richard's life and his family's future.
